Equine Therapy (27%)

Camp Summit, Inc.: To enhance and repair the camper loading area and provide loafing sheds for the horses.

Stars and Strides Therapeutic Riding Center: To support veterinary expenses and farrier services for elderly equine.

Wings of Hope: For the construction of a loafing shed and food to keep the herd healthy.

Equine Welfare (8%)

Parker County Sheriff's Reserve: To provide specialized veterinary services for abused and neglected horses in Parker County.

Land Conservation (65%)

Camp Fire First Texas: To provide funding for Title 1 schools to attend the Texas Outdoor Education Center.
