## Our Name & Fund Names

North Texas Community Foundation is our full name (no "the"). You can also refer to us as "the Community Foundation," "the Foundation" or "NTCF" as long as our full name is used first.

When acknowledging a specific fund at NTCF, please use the following language: [Name of Fund] at North Texas Community Foundation.

Please do not credit a fund name without inclusion of the Community Foundation's name. The fund name without reference to NTCF should be used only if the phrase "[Name of Fund] at North Texas Community Foundation" has been used first in that specific communication.

## Logo Use

Our full-color, primary logo should be used whenever possible. Some instances may require a white, horizontal or icon version of our logo, which can be provided upon request.

Our signature grant cycles — Better Together Fund, Fund to Advance Racial Equity, ToolBox, WORTH, — have their own logos which may be used when referring to those programs and are available upon request.

NTCF Logo Use Requirements:

- The logo must be used as provided and cannot be altered in design.
- The proportions, color and typography should not be modified.
- The width of the minimum clear space should be equal to the height of the first text box within the logo. Please do not place any text, graphics or images within this area.
